

Altogether Group's Water balance competition TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Who can enter?

- 1. Altogether's *Water balance* competition is open to all residents over the age of 18 years residing in The Gables, Pitt Town, Huntlee, or Watagan Park/Cooranbong:
 - a. whose home is connected to the Altogether recycled water network; and
 - b. who can prove the use of recycled water at their home over the entry period
- 2. Entrants are not eligible to participate in the *Water balance* competition if they breach any of these terms and conditions or are an employee or an immediate family member of an employee of Altogether Group.
- 3. By entering our *Water balance* competition, the entrant confirms that they meet the entry eligibility requirements and accept these terms and conditions.

How can you enter the Altogether Water balance competition?

- 4. Entrants must complete and submit the entry form at https://altogethergroup.com.au/water-balance-competition/
- 5. Entries need to be supported by a minimum of 2 photos (and a short description/caption) including one photo of the family/residents of the house. These can be submitted at any time within the competition period.
- 6. Entrants can enter multiple categories, but can only win in one category.
- 7. For the 'Creative Promotion Video' category, entrants must propose, in a short video (maximum duration of 1 minute), creative ways recycled water can be used to encourage smart household consumption.
- 8. An optional requirement is the entrant commits to using, each month over the competition period, at least 20% more recycled water than before the competition period.

How the winners will be chosen:

- 9. The winner in each category will be chosen from entrants who:
 - a. meet the entry eligibility requirements set out under 'Who can enter?'; and
 - b. receive, until 12 midnight 1 October 2022, the greatest number of likes on Altogether's Facebook posts. https://www.facebook.com/altogethergroup
- 10. In case of a tie, the winner will be selected as the entrant whose home uses the highest amount of recycled water on a per square meter basis.

Key dates:

- Entry period (when Altogether will be accepting submissions)
 1 August 2022 30 September 2022.
- 12. Voting period, when Altogether will be displaying the entries on the Facebook page to accept 'likes': **1 August 2022– 30 September 2022.**
 - Entries with Pictures/Videos will be posted once a week on a Tuesday.
- 13. Winners' announcement: 5 October 2022.

Costs and expenses

14. Entrants are responsible for all expenses that they incur in entering or winning our *Water* balance competition. Entrants will not be reimbursed for any expenses, regardless of whether they are a winner.

Privacy

- 15. By entering our *Water balance* competition, entrants' consent to:
 - a. the use and disclosure of their personal information in accordance with our Privacy Policy; and
 - b. Altogether reserving the right to use the participants and/or winners and their families' (minors included) name and address, photographs and audio and/or visual recordings in any publicity such as: social media and media releases, Altogether website and in post-event promotions.

By entering our *Water balance* competition, the entrant consents to Altogether (including its related entities and agents), supplying photography of them or anyone featured in the pictures or videos submitted by them (including minors) and any written content supplied by them in promotional and editorial material, including publications, marketing material, videos, television, and webcasts.
